

CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

In an effort to increase community awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the recent actions of the Huber Heights City Council through its meetings and legislative actions. This information will also further promote a better understanding of the role played by the City Council in keeping Huber Heights a great community in which to live, work, play, and visit.

City Council took the following actions at the July 26, 2021 City Council Meeting:

- Postponed action indefinitely and tabled a resolution at the fourth reading to award contracts for the Dial Park Trails and Bike Amenities Project.
- Approved a motion for an appointment to the Military and Veterans Commission.
- Held a Public Hearing and approved a resolution to give elected representative approval in connection with the issuance of tax-exempt bonds by the Public Finance Authority for the Landings of Huber Heights at 6200 Bellefontaine Road.
- Approved a resolution to authorize an additional capital lease with U.S. Bancorp to fund Change Order #3 to the City's Guaranteed Energy Savings Performance Contract (GESPC) with Energy Systems Group, LLC (ESG).
- Approved a resolution to approve a property owner's request at 9140 Adams Road in Greene County outside of the City limits to connect to the City's water system.
