



CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

In an effort to increase community awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the recent actions of the Huber Heights City Council through its meetings and legislative actions. This information will also further promote a better understanding of the role played by the City Council in keeping Huber Heights a great community in which to live, work, play, and visit.

City Council took the following actions at the April 12, 2021 City Council Meeting:

- The Fire Chief presented the newly promoted Battalion Chiefs and Lieutenants in the Fire Division to the City Council and the public.
- The Mayor presented a proclamation declaring April 11-17, 2021 as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week.
- Approved a motion for a reappointment to the Huber Heights Housing Council.
- Held a Public Hearing and passed an ordinance to a second reading in Zoning Case 21-08 to approve a Rezoning to PR (Planned Residential) and a Basic Development Plan for 14.18 acres at Bellefontaine Road and Fishburg Road.
- Waived the second reading and approved an ordinance to authorize various supplemental appropriations.
- Approved a resolution to declare phones/other equipment in the Police Division as surplus property and to authorize the donation of phones/other equipment to the Artemis Center.
- Approved a resolution to purchase a new ambulance for the Fire Division.
- Approved two (2) resolutions to increase the not to exceed spending amounts for vendors:
 - Phoenix Safety Outfitters – Fire Division
 - HSI – IT Department
- Approved a resolution to purchase a new vehicle for the Engineering Division.
- Approved three (3) resolutions to awards contracts for the Engineering Division:
 - Demolition – Needmore Road Water Treatment Plant – Award Contract
 - Rehabilitation of Water Lines Project – Award Contract
 - Rehabilitation of Sewer Lines Project – Award Contract
