

CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

In an effort to increase community awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the recent actions of the Huber Heights City Council through its meetings and legislative actions. This information will also further promote a better understanding of the role played by the City Council in keeping Huber Heights a great community in which to live, work, play, and visit.

City Council took the following actions at the April 26, 2021 City Council Meeting:

- The Mayor presented a proclamation declaring May 2-8, 2021 as Professional Municipal Clerks Week.
- Had a presentation on the Suez Water 2020 Annual Report.
- Approved an amended ordinance in Zoning Case 21-08 to approve a Rezoning to PR (Planned Residential) and a Basic Development Plan for 14.18 acres at Bellefontaine Road and Fishburg Road.
- Approved motions for an appointment to the Parks and Recreation Board, reappointments to the Arts and Beautification Commission, and reappointments to the Ordinance Review Commission.
- Passed an ordinance to a second reading to approve a Supplement 7 update to the City
- Approved a resolution to approve an agreement for the annual renewal of the City's liability insurance.
- Approved a resolution to approve an amendment to the Ohio Public Employees 457
 Deferred Compensation Plan to add a Roth 457 option.
- Approved a resolution to approve a lease for Benchrock Farm, LLC to use 35 acres of City-owned land on the Lehman Farm for agricultural purposes.
