



CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

In an effort to increase community awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the recent actions of the Huber Heights City Council through its meetings and legislative actions. This information will also further promote a better understanding of the role played by the City Council in keeping Huber Heights a great community in which to live, work, play, and visit.

City Council took the following actions at the May 10, 2021 City Council Meeting:

- The Police Chief presented the newly hired Police Officers in the Police Division to the City Council and the public.
- The Mayor presented a proclamation declaring May 9-15, 2021 as National Police Week.
- The Mayor presented a proclamation declaring May 14, 2021 as Pam Byrd Day to acknowledge the retirement of Pam Byrd from the Huber Heights City Schools.
- Approved an ordinance at the second reading to approve a Supplement 7 update to the City Code.
- Approved a motion to respond to the Ohio Division of Liquor Control with no objections in reference to the transfer of a liquor permit for Pit Stop Drive Thru Market at 5701 Old Troy Pike.
- Approved a resolution to authorize the Law Director to register an objection to a liquor permit for Sneaky D's at 5478 Brandt Pike to the Ohio Division of Liquor Control and to request a hearing.
- Approved a resolution to authorize a short-term contract renewal with Republic Services for City trash hauling services through July 30, 2021.
- Approved a resolution to authorize capital improvements to the Rose Music Center including magnetometers and sound baffles and waiving the competitive bidding requirements.
- Approved a resolution to authorize a Request For Proposals for a multi-use skate park and BMX track at Monita Park.
- Approved a resolution to authorize a Request For Proposals for multi-use trails, a bicycle skills park, a bicycle playground, and an asphalt pump track at Dial Park.
- Approved a resolution authorizing the City to participate in the Ohio Association of Public Treasurers 2022 Workers' Compensation Group Experience Rating Program.
- Approved a resolution authorizing the execution of a Memorandum of Understanding with DDC Management, LLC regarding a single-family residential subdivision off Chambersburg Road.
- Waived the second reading and approved an emergency ordinance to authorize a water service connection assessment for a property at 4517 Fishburg Road.
