

CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

In an effort to increase community awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the recent actions of the Huber Heights City Council through its meetings and legislative actions. This information will also further promote a better understanding of the role played by the City Council in keeping Huber Heights a great community in which to live, work, play, and visit.

City Council took the following actions at the May 24, 2021 City Council Meeting:

- The Mayor presented a proclamation declaring June, 2021 as LGBTQ Pride Month in the City of Huber Heights.
- Held a Public Hearing and waived the second reading and approved an ordinance in Zoning Case 21-11 to approve a rezoning from I-1 (Light Industrial) to PR (Planned Residential District) for property at 4401 Taylorsville Road.
- Approved a resolution to authorize a new five-year contract with Republic Services for City residential trash hauling services.
- Passed a resolution to a second reading to approve the 2022-2026 City of Huber Heights Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).
- Waived the second reading and approved an ordinance to authorize various supplemental appropriations.
- Approved a Resolution Of Necessity to approve special assessments for Windbrooke Subdivision Section 3-2.
- Passed an Ordinance To Proceed to a second reading to approve special assessments for Windbrooke Subdivision Section 3-2.
