

CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

In an effort to increase community awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the recent actions of the Huber Heights City Council through its meetings and legislative actions. This information will also further promote a better understanding of the role played by the City Council in keeping Huber Heights a great community in which to live, work, play, and visit.

City Council took the following actions at the June 14, 2021 City Council Meeting:

- The Police Chief presented the newly promoted Sergeants in the Police Division to the City Council and the public.
- The Mayor presented a proclamation commemorating Junteenth in the City of Huber Heights to the Huber Heights Culture and Diversity Citizen Action Commission.
- The Mayor presented proclamations to the Wayne High School Class of 2021
 Valedictorian Sarai Combs and Salutatorian Philip Le.
- Made a Public Announcement regarding the final cost to property owners of the 2021 Sidewalk Program.
- Approved a resolution to approve the 2022-2026 City of Huber Heights Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).
- Approved an Ordinance To Proceed to approve special assessments for Windbrooke Subdivision Section 3-2.
- Approved motions for an appointment to the Parks and Recreation Board and an appointment to the Arts and Beautification Commission.
- Held a Public Hearing and waived the second reading and approved an ordinance in Zoning Case 21-17 to approve a Major Change to the Basic and Detailed Development Plans for property at 7536 Brandt Pike for Kyle Flaming.
- Held a Public Hearing and waived the second reading and approved an ordinance in Zoning Case 21-14 to approve a Major Change to the Basic Development Plan and a rezoning from R-4 (Residence) to PR (Planned Residential) for properties on Chambersburg Road for Campbell Berling Huber Heights, LLC.
- Held a Public Hearing and waived the second reading and approved an ordinance in Zoning Case 21-16 to approve a rezoning from R-6 (Residence) and B-3 (Commercial) to Planned Mixed Use and a Basic Development Plan for properties at the northeast corner of Taylorsville Road and Old Troy Pike for Broadreach Retail Partners, LLC.
- Waived the second reading and approved an ordinance to authorize various supplemental appropriations.
- Approved a resolution to increase the not to exceed spending amount for Accountemps for the Tax Division.
- Approved a resolution to accept funding from the American Rescue Plan Act and to establish the American Rescue Plan Fund.

- Approved a resolution to award contracts for the Monita Field Park Skate Park and BMX Track Project.
- Passed a resolution to a second reading to award contracts for the Dial Park Trails and Bike Amenities Project.
- Held a discussion on Merily Way and related traffic issues.
