



CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

In an effort to increase community awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the recent actions of the Huber Heights City Council through its meetings and legislative actions. This information will also further promote a better understanding of the role played by the City Council in keeping Huber Heights a great community in which to live, work, play, and visit.

City Council took the following actions at the April 20, 2021 Council Work Session:

- Recommended placing a resolution for a first reading on the agenda at the April 26, 2021 City Council Meeting to approve an agreement for the annual renewal of the City's liability insurance.
- Recommended placing a resolution for a first reading on the agenda at the April 26, 2021 City Council Meeting to approve an amendment to the Ohio Public Employees 457 Deferred Compensation Plan to add a Roth 457 option.
- Recommended placing a resolution for a first reading on the agenda at the April 26, 2021 City Council Meeting to approve a lease for Benchrock Farm, LLC to use 35 acres of City-owned land on the Lehman Farm for agricultural purposes.
- Discussed the three proposals received for the City's residential trash hauling services.
- Recommended placing an ordinance for a first reading on the agenda at the April 26, 2021 City Council Meeting to adopt Supplement 7 to the City Code.
- Recommended placing motions on the agenda at the April 26, 2021 City Council Meeting for an appointment to the Parks and Recreation Board and reappointments to the Arts and Beautification Commission and the Ordinance Review Commission.
