

CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

In an effort to increase community awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the recent actions of the Huber Heights City Council through its meetings and legislative actions. This information will also further promote a better understanding of the role played by the City Council in keeping Huber Heights a great community in which to live, work, play, and visit.

City Council took the following actions at the May 5, 2021 Council Work Session:

- Discussed the process for selecting a trash hauling vendor for the new contract for the City's residential trash hauling services and recommended a Town Hall Meeting and the next Council Work Session be scheduled for resident input and feedback and discussion by the City Council on this matter.
- Recommended placing a resolution for a first reading on the agenda at the May 10, 2021 City Council Meeting to approve a thirty-day extension of the current trash hauling contract with Republic Services which expires on June 30, 2021.
