

CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

In an effort to increase community awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the recent actions of the Huber Heights City Council through its meetings and legislative actions. This information will also further promote a better understanding of the role played by the City Council in keeping Huber Heights a great community in which to live, work, play, and visit.

City Council took the following actions at the May 18, 2021 Council Work Session:

- Recommended placing a public hearing and an ordinance for a first reading on the agenda at the May 24, 2021 City Council Meeting for ZC 21-11 for a rezoning for property at 4401 Taylorsville Road.
- Recommended placing an ordinance for a first reading on the agenda at the May 24, 2021 City Council Meeting to approve various supplemental appropriations.
- Recommended placing a resolution for a first reading on the agenda at the May 24, 2021 City Council Meeting to approve the 2022-2026 City of Huber Heights Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).
- Recommended placing a Resolution Of Necessity for a first reading on the agenda at the May 24, 2021 City Council Meeting for special assessments for lots in Section 3-2 of the Windbrooke Subdivision.
- Recommended placing an Ordinance To Proceed for a first reading on the agenda at the May 24, 2021 City Council Meeting for special assessments for lots in Section 3-2 of the Windbrooke Subdivision.
- Recommended placing a resolution for a first reading on the agenda at the May 24, 2021 City Council Meeting to approve a new five-year Citywide residential trash hauling contract with Republic Services.
