

CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

In an effort to increase community awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the recent actions of the Huber Heights City Council through its meetings and legislative actions. This information will also further promote a better understanding of the role played by the City Council in keeping Huber Heights a great community in which to live, work, play, and visit.

City Council took the following actions at the July 20, 2021 Council Work Session:

- Recommended placing a resolution for a first reading on the agenda at the July 26, 2021
 City Council Meeting to approve a property owner's request at 9140 Adams Road in
 Greene County outside of the City limits to connect to the City's water system.
- Recommended placing an ordinance for a first reading on the agenda at the July 26, 2021 City Council Meeting to give elected representative approval in connection with the issuance of tax-exempt bonds by the Public Finance Authority for the Landings of Huber Heights at 6200 Bellefontaine Road.
- Had a presentation from the Finance Director regarding the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the City's finances and revenues in 2020.
- Recommended placing a resolution for a first reading on the agenda at the July 26, 2021
 City Council Meeting to authorize an additional capital lease with U.S. Bancorp to fund
 Change Order #3 to the City's Guaranteed Energy Savings Performance Contract
 (GESPC) with Energy Systems Group, LLC (ESG).
- Discussed the City's emergency notification systems.
- Discussed the current status of the City's new trash hauling contract with Republic Services and the efforts to address service issues, billing issues, and resident complaints with Republic Services.
- Discussed a resolution scheduled for a fourth reading on the agenda at the July 26, 2021 City Council Meeting to approve the construction of a mountain bike trail, bicycle skills park, bicycle playground, and pump track at Dial Park in conjunction with a discussion about parking issues at Dial Park, amenities for Dial Park, and possible alternative locations for some of these park amenities. Recommended tabling the resolution at the fourth reading at the July 26, 2021 City Council Meeting.
- Had a presentation on the activities and business of the Parks and Recreation Board.
- Discussed the Brandt Pike Revitalization Project.
- Discussed the Huber Heights Senior Center Comprehensive Plan.
- Recommended placing a motion on the agenda at the July 26, 2021 City Council Meeting for an appointment to the Military and Veterans Commission.
