



CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

In an effort to increase community awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the recent actions of the Huber Heights City Council through its meetings and legislative actions. This information will also further promote a better understanding of the role played by the City Council in keeping Huber Heights a great community in which to live, work, play, and visit.

City Council took the following actions at the August 2, 2021 Council Work Session:

- Recommended placing an ordinance for a first reading on the agenda at the August 9, 2021 City Council Meeting to issue renewal notes in the amount of \$3,750,000 originally issued to pay the costs of acquiring and site preparation of approximately 51 acres of property near the intersection of Brandt Pike and Executive Boulevard (Lehman property).
- Recommended placing a resolution for a first reading on the agenda at the August 9, 2021 City Council Meeting to accept federal funding from the Shuttered Venue Operators Grant (SVOG) Program for the Rose Music Center and to create the Shuttered Venue Operators Grant Fund.
- Discussed a proposed plan to create a Traffic Control Unit in the Police Division.
- Discussed various parks improvement projects, including bike amenities, sports fields, and parks improvements to Monita Park and the Huber Heights Community Center.
- Discussed the Brandt Pike Revitalization Project.
- Recommended placing a motion on the agenda at the August 9, 2021 City Council Meeting for an appointment to the Citizens Water and Sewer Advisory Board.
- Had an update from the Law Director on nuisance properties and other matters.
